THE STATISTICS



62% of children are physically harmed by their abuser



25% of children living in high-risk households are under the age of 3 years old



130,000 children live in homes where there is high-risk domestic abuse

DOMESTIC ABUSE IS AN EPIDEMIC AND EDUCATION MUST BE PART OF THE SOLUTION.

We know four out of five victims do not call the police.

You are the 'eyes and ears' in the community: together we can reach out to victims where they feel supported, where they feel safe and free from stigma.

These statistics are frightening and demonstrate why we need to take action. education professionals are ideally placed to make that difference.

TRAINING PACKAGES

Basic Domestic Abuse Awareness: 1hr

Suitable for anyone.

- Understand tactics and risk related to domestic abuse and coercive control
- -Understand the cycle of abuse
- Learn how to spot the signs of domestic domestic abuse in adults, children and abuse in colleagues and parents
- Understand the impact of domestic abuse on adults and parenting
- Know how to provide crisis support for anyone experiencing domestic abuse
- Initial safety planning and signposting to specialist services

DASH Champions Foundation Training: 2 hrs

For anyone who has completed basic DA training.

- Understand the different forms of domestic abuse including stalking and coercive control
- Learn how to encourage & respond to disclosures of domestic abuse
- Recognise the Stages of Change
- Understand the cycle of abuse and challenges of leaving an abusive relationship
- Understand the different levels of risk
- Know your internal, local and specialist services to signpost to
- Guidance on how to make the most of being a DA Champion

Domestic Abuse and Safeguarding: 1/2 day

For anyone who has completed Champions training.

At the end of our course your attendees will have gained:

- Understanding of the complexities of young parents
- Practical skills to spot the signs of domestic abuse
- Understanding of how to support children experiencing domestic abuse
- Understanding of civil/criminal Orders related to children
- Confidence to step in and offer support to a victim who may need help
- Enhanced interpersonal skills related to active listening and empathetic response -Knowledge around diversity and barriers to support
- Knowledge of internal, local and national services where adults or children can be signposted to for support
- Understanding of safeguarding related to domestic abuse
- A Domestic Abuse action plan toolkit

This training can be adapted to suit your organisational and learning needs.
